#### Multiple Response Question Success Tips:

Because each question has more than one correct answer, each correct answer selected earns a portion of the total points for the question. When you select only 1 answer you do not earn points for the correct answers not selected. Given a question with 4 choices, 2 correct and 2 incorrect, each correct answer selected earns 50% of the point value. However, each incorrect answer chosen deducts a portion of the points. So, choosing 2 correct answers and 1 incorrect answer in this example results in 50% of total points: 100% for correct answers less 50% for the incorrect answer. With scoring in mind, consider these Techniques to improve MR question scores:

First, don't try to sort through all of the answer choices at once. Instead look at them one at a time as if each is a true/false question. For example, given the question "Which of these letters are in the first half of the alphabet? A, C, J, X" you can think of it as four true/false questions: (1) True or False: A is in the first half of the alphabet, (2) True or False: C is in the first half of the alphabet, (3) True or False: J is in the first half of the alphabet, (4) True or False: X is in the first half of the first half of the alphabet or False: X is in the first half of the alphabet. Mark as correct only those choices where you believe the statements are true.

Second, think probability when marking answers as correct. Remember that every MR question has more than 1 correct answer and at least 1 incorrect answer. Always select more than one

answer and never select all of them. Also remember that you earn points for choosing correct answers and you lose points for choosing incorrect answers. A question with 4 choices will have either 2 or 3 correct choices. For these questions, if you choose 2 correct answers when 3 are correct you will score 66.66% of the total points. But if you choose 3 answers when only 2 are correct the best possible score is 50%. This means that it is smart to to choose the two answers that you are most confident are correct and choose a 3rd answer only if you strongly believe it to be correct. Don't choose the 3rd answer if you're uncertain. Most of the MR questions that you encounter will have 4 choices of answers. When you see questions with more than 4 choices apply the same logic. If 5 choices, choose the 3 where you are most confident and a 4th only if you're sure that it is also correct.

## **Common Exam Questions Answered**

#### Q: Why does my exam status say "In Progress" when I answered all the questions?

**A:** You had either a fatal loss of internet connection or a browser crash while taking the exam. Unfortunately, when you experience a connection error the exam results are not saved. This is why your exam status still shows "In Progress". If the results are saved successfully exam status should be "Completed". Unfortunately, in this scenario you will have to retake the exam.

Most crashes are random events. They also can be caused by your browser/network security settings. To verify your browser settings, please, go to <u>https://elearningcurve.inquisiqr4.com/</u> and click on the 'System Test' link located in the footer of the page. Then click on the 'Test My Workstation' button and verify that everything (even the popup blocker) is check-marked green.

A browser crash could also be a result of your security settings. If you work behind VPN on your personal device, or if you are using your company's network, those settings could prevent your browser from sending information to the server.

#### Q: How do I know how many questions I have left?

**A:** Please refer to the question list link at the top left on your exam. This will help you gauge how far along on the exam you are.

#### Q: Can I retake a passed exam?

**A:** Occasionally students want to retake an exam they passed to try and get a better score, especially if they are attempting to earn a certification. Please contact us at <u>admin@elearningcurve.com</u> and we can reset your exam if you would like to retake it.

#### Q: How soon can I retake an exam I failed?

You must wait for the e-mail informing you that you passed or failed. Do not retake the exam until you receive the results e-mail even if you feel that you failed. The system will not be able to save the second set of results. Once you receive the results and are re-enrolled, you can retake the exam at any time.

#### Q: May I have a transcript of the exam questions and my answers?

**A:** Unfortunately, we cannot provide a transcript of the exam questions and your answers. While we completely understand why you would want this information, it is a requirement of all industry-standard certification programs that the answers to questions are not divulged. This rule is meant to preserve the integrity of the exam process.

#### Q: How much time is needed to prepare for an exam?

**A:** Actual time spent in preparation for an exam will vary from student to student. Some students will pause to take notes during the course and listen to some material multiple times. Others will move through the course very quickly. In general you should plan for 30 minutes to an hour of preparation per hour of course time.

#### Q: Why have I not received my exam results?

**A:** We send your exam results via email. Occasionally a corporate email server will block our emails from landing in your inbox. If you are able, please whitelist emails from eLearningCurve. Alternatively, you can provide a different email address where we can resend your results.
